AMENDMENTS IN CONSTITUTION OF KANPUR Figure 1 ORTHOPAEDIC ASSOCIATION

The Association will have a legally elected executive committee comprising of followings

President -One

V.P. - One

Secretary - One

Joint Sec. - One

Treasurer - One

Ex. Members -Five (Elected)

All past Presidents and Secretaries will be ex-officio members of the executive committee . For smooth running of the association it must be made clear that the President of the association is constitutionally the supreme authority and no decision will be taken without the consent of the President. No circular will be issued by the secretary of his own without the consent and approval of the President , whatever may be the circumstances. Any member who aspires to be member of the executive must be member of the Parent body , the UPOA and IOA

PRESIDENT

TENURE .

Tenure of President will be for one year only ,

Eligible candidates can also contest the election for a second term as well but not in continuation

ELIGIBILITY

1. Should have Life member for more than 10 years
2. Should have been attending scientific meetings of KOA regularly for minimum 7 years
3. Should have attended minimum 5 morning scientific meetings of KOA every year in last 2 proceeding years
4. Should have delivered atleast 3 lectures in scientific meetings excluding case presentations
- 5 The candidate should be residing and practising / in service in Kanpur during the tenure

VICE PRESIDENT

TENURE .

Tenure of Vice President will be for one year only ,

Eligible candidates can also contest the election for a second term as well but not in continuation

ELIGIBILITY

1. Should have Life member for more than 8 years
2. Should have been attending scientific meetings of KOA regularly for minimum 6 years
3. Should have attended minimum 4 morning scientific meetings of KOA every year in last 2 proceeding years
4. Should have delivered atleast 1 lectures in scientific meetings excluding case presentations
5. The candidate should be residing and practising / in service in Kanpur during the tenure

Secretary

TENURE .

Tenure of Secretary will be for 2year only ,

One can also contest the election for second term also but not in continuation

ELIGIBILITY

1. Should have Life member for more than 7 years
2. Should have been attending scientific meetings of KOA for minimum 5 years
3. Should have attended minimum 4 morning scientific meetings of KOA every year in last 2 proceeding years
4. Should have delivered atleast 1 lecture in scientific meetings excluding case presentations
5. The candidate should be residing and practising / in service in Kanpur during the tenure

Treasurer

TENURE .

Tenure of Secretary will be for 2year only ,

One can also contest the election for second term also but not in continuation

ELIGIBILITY

1. Should have Life member for more than 5 years
2. Should have been attending scientific meetings of KOA for minimum 3 years
3. Should have attended minimum 3 morning scientific meetings of KOA every year in last 2 proceeding years
4. The candidate should be residing and practising / in service in Kanpur during the tenure

Joint Secretary

The candidate has to be Life member of the KOA and of course life member of UPOA

For a better coordination between President and secretary the joint secretary will be nominated by the President

TIME OF ELECTION

The Elections will be held every year in its last meeting of the year (Dec. meeting) preferably on the day which does not coincides with Gems function i.e., it may be 3rd Sunday

ELECTION COMMISSIONER

The senior most orthopaedic member present on the day of election will be nominated as election commissioner

MEMBERSHIP FEE

The life membership fee for new member will be Rs.1500/ for full membership

ASSOCIATE membership fee will be Rs. 500/ only ,open only for PG students throughout the tenure of PG course and this money of Rs 500/ will be adjusted against the life membership fee as and when the PG is eligible for life membership provided he joins UPOA and IOA as life member
